## Alternatives to the annual, 2-day Lakes Region HHW Collections

Lakes Region Household Hazardous Product Facility (Wolfeboro, NH) accepts
hazardous waste from residents and businesses in New Hampshire every 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday,
May through October from 8:30AM – 12PM.



- o Household disposal fee is \$40 for every 5 gallons of waste
- o Businesses need to call ahead, households do not need an appointment

- **Pemi-Baker Solid Waste District** allows businesses and non-district residents to drop off hazardous waste to the scheduled collections in Plymouth and Littleton, for a fee. Businesses must pre-register.
  - o Fee for non-district residents is \$25 per 5 gallons or 20 pounds of waste

Up to 10 gallons: \$50
 10 - 20 gallons: \$100
 20 - 50 gallons: \$125
