He plans to return once conditions improve to complete the work. He has also postponed work at the Whitney Glidden Cemetery.

The trustees discussed several options for the upcoming June workshop with Jessica Davis. It was decided that the Field Jones Cemetery on Sodom Road would be an appropriate cemetery to do needed headstone repairs and cleaning. Sue Weeks will coordinate a date and time with Jessica who prefers an early June date.

Guy Pike will contact Mark Eldridge to ask him to attend our April meeting to discuss cemetery maintenance for the upcoming season.
